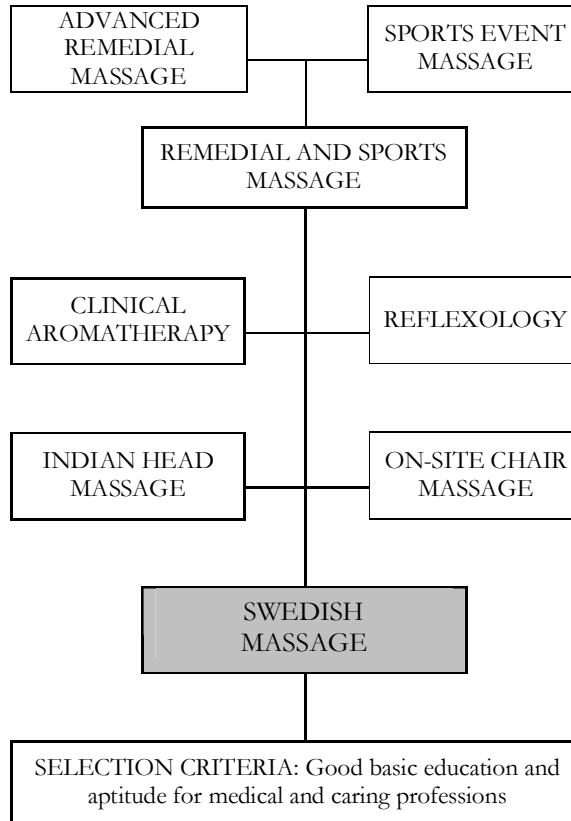

SWEDISH MASSAGE
