## **DIPLOMA IN ADVANCED REMEDIAL MASSAGE**

Thank you for your interest in our ten-month Diploma in Advanced Remedial Massage course. You require a Diploma in Remedial & Sports Massage or equivalent to be able to apply for this course – if you are unsure of your qualification, please get in touch.

This course is designed to continue on from Remedial & Sports Massage leading the student through more detailed anatomy and physiology with emphasis on specific examination procedures and techniques for treating lesions of joints. Advanced Remedial Massage works mainly on the mechanics of the body and the circulatory and nervous systems. The student will learn that correction of structural imbalances can have far-reaching effects on many conditions.

The Advanced Remedial Massage course is held one weekend a month for 10 months, 8.30am-5pm both days. There will also be several additional opportunities to attend workshops which will compliment what is taught on the Advanced Remedial course.

The course will be held in Edinburgh on 14<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup> Jan, 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> Feb, 10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> March, 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> April (Easter), 12<sup>th</sup>/13<sup>th</sup> May, 9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup> June, 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> July, 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> August, 8<sup>th</sup>/9<sup>th</sup> Sept and 29<sup>th</sup>/30<sup>th</sup> Sept 2012.

There will be set written work and home study after each course weekend. A method of continuous assessment is in operation via a credit system. Credits are gained by attendance at course weekends, homeworks, tests, essays and case studies. A 90% attendance at weekends is required before the final examinations (which include practical, oral and written assessments) can be sat.

The cost of the course is £2,250, made up by a non-refundable registration fee is £250 and tuition fees of £2,000. The tuition fees may be paid at the beginning of the course or in nine (9) instalments of £230, by banker's order. All fees must be paid by weekend nine (9) and there are no refunds after weekend one (1).

On successful completion of the course, you will be awarded a Diploma in Advanced Remedial Massage and you will be able to use the letters D.A.R.M. after your name. This will entitle you to practise as an Advanced Remedial Massage Therapist and procure insurance for the new techniques you have learned.

However, you may wish to continue to study on the Diploma in Manipulative Therapy course – this can be done as a follow on. Bob Macaskill is running the Manipulative Therapy course starting in Sept 2012. If you decide to continue studying please ask the office for the relevant registration forms.
