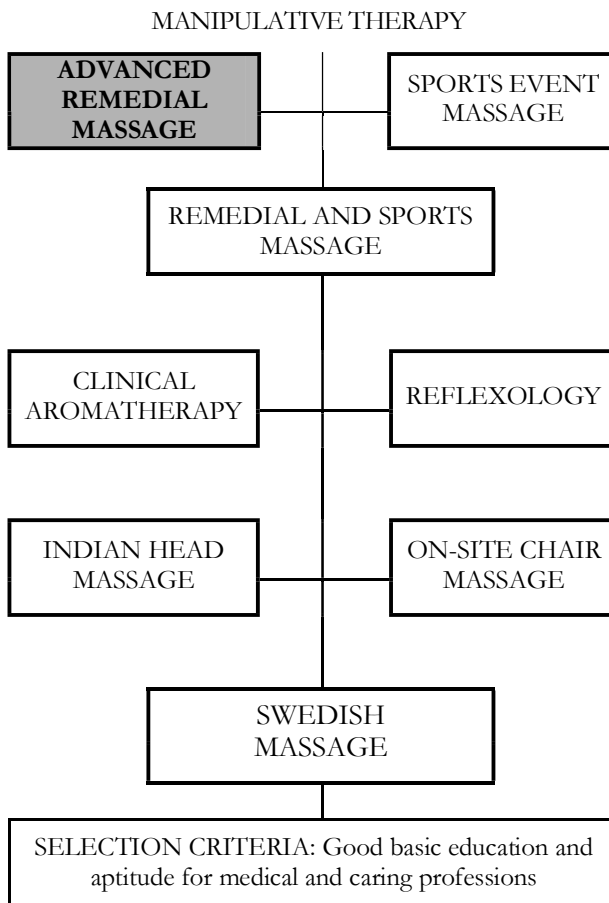

ADVANCED REMEDIAL MASSAGE

Advanced Remedial Massage involves specific techniques to assess and treat lesions of joints. The methods and protocols build upon those learned in Swedish and Remedial & Sports Massage. Advanced Remedial Massage works mainly on the mechanics of the body and the circulatory and nervous systems. The student will learn that correction of structural imbalances can have far-reaching effects on many conditions.

Prospects for career development are very good as there is a large and growing demand for the particular skills and knowledge of well-trained Advanced Remedial Massage Therapists.
