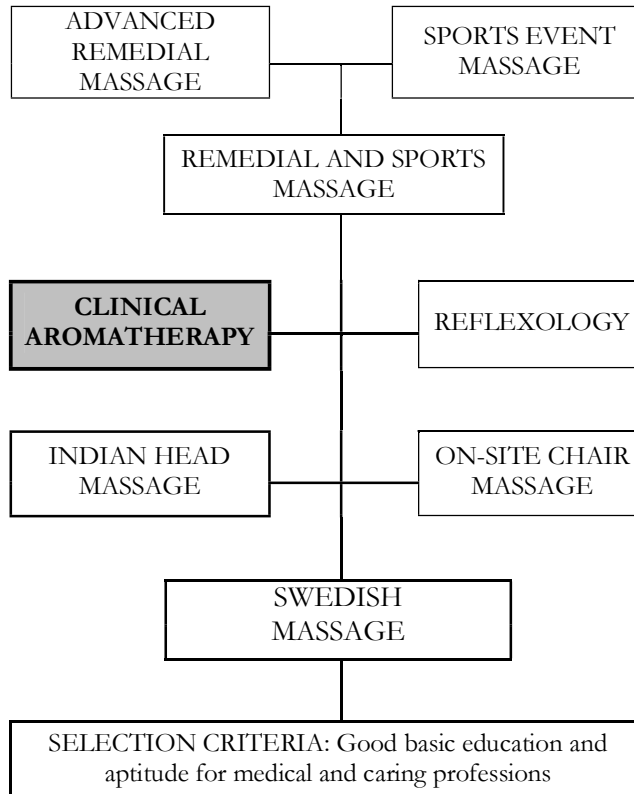

CONTENT

The subjects include history and philosophy of Aromatherapy, plant and essential oil chemistry, safety procedures, methods of application, consultations and individual prescribing, blending principles, hygiene, first aid, ethics, plus building and promoting a Clinical Aromatherapy practice.

DIPLOMA IN CLINICAL AROMATHERAPY

The Clinical Aromatherapy Diploma course is designed to give the Massage Therapist comprehensive training in all aspects of essential oils and their uses. The goal is for the Therapist to enter into practice as a professional Clinical Aromatherapist, able to prescribe blends appropriately.

There is, of course, the option of a second business evolving in the production and selling of essential oil products.

This course is recognised by the Scottish Massage Therapists Organisation (SMTO) and follows the guidelines as set by the Aromatherapy Organisations Council (AOC).

The aim of the School is to provide a centre of excellence for the therapy. Modules are available on request.
