REFLEXOLOGY DIPLOMA COURSE

Thank you for your interest in the Scottish Massage Schools Reflexology Diploma course. Courses are held in Aberdeen, Edinburgh and Inverness.

This course is intended to provide post-graduate training for massage therapists, as a knowledge and understanding of anatomy, physiology, pathology, practice management and physical therapy is required. If you wish details of our Swedish Massage feeder course, please ask.

The Reflexology Course consists of 6 weekends, 8.30am-5pm both days, and the cost of the course is £950. The non-refundable deposit is £250. You may pay the remaining £700 at the beginning of the course or in four further instalments of £190, by banker's order, cheque, cash or credit card.

The **Edinburgh** course will be held in Edinburgh Academy Junior School, 10 Arboretum Road, Edinburgh EH3 5PL on: 28th/29th January, 25th/26th February, 17th/18th March, 21st/22nd April, 26th/27th May and 16th/17th June **2012**.

The **Aberdeen** course will be held in Curl Aberdeen, Eday Walk, Summerhill, Aberdeen, AB15 6LN on: 5th/6th May, 2nd/3rd June, 30th June/1st July, 4th/5th Aug, 1st/2nd Sept, 6th/7th Oct **2012**.

The Reflexology course will be taught by **Angela Keith** in Edinburgh and **Jill Tees** in Aberdeen.

If you wish to reserve a place on this course then please fill in the registration form on the brochure. We will acknowledge and send you more information, then. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Case studies and homework will also be part of the course and a final written and practical assessment will have to be completed and passed before a Diploma is awarded.
