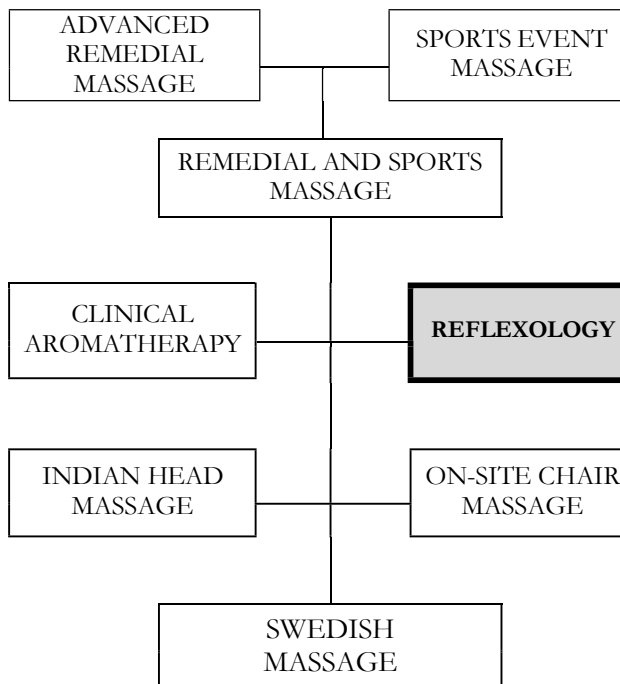

DIPLOMA IN REFLEXOLOGY

The Reflexology Diploma course is designed to lead the physical therapist through techniques for restoring balance and harmony to the mind and body, by working on the physical and emotional body mapped out on the hands and feet.

As health deteriorates, energy becomes blocked. Reflexology helps this energy to flow efficiently again, giving the body the chance to heal itself.

Reflexology can also be used as a diagnostic tool and to relieve stress, as well as help the body to deal with pathological conditions

Business Management forms part of the course and the graduate may choose to be either self-employed or seek employment at a Health Centre, Complementary Centre, Sports Club or Hotel.
